Play Centre Rules

- Children should never be left unattended.
- Smoking and alcohol are strictly prohibited on the premises.
- Only adults over 18 years may supervise children under 5 on the equipment.
- Parents and carers remain responsible for their children at all times.
- Children aged 12 – 18 years pay an admission charge only and must not use the equipment.
- No food, drink or chewing gum allowed on the equipment.
- No glassware is to be brought into or used on the premises.
- Shoes must be removed before entering the play area but socks must be worn at all times.
- Arms and legs should be covered. Remove jewellery, badges and all other sharp objects.
- No climbing the equipment netting.
- Up to two adults may accompany a child on the equipment at any one time.
- Children who are unwell should not use the play equipment.
- No running in restaurant seating areas.
- Leave all personal items such as money with parents/carers or in a locker provided.
- Children who wear glasses or contact lenses should take particular care.
- During busy times, play sessions are for two hours only. 4 hour sessions are available at an additional cost.
- Ashford Play Centre Ltd can not accept liability for any losses, damage or theft.
- Unsociable behaviour or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Only food bought on the premises may be consumed here.
- Baby seats and high chairs are for babies only.

Play Centre Safety Conditions

- The baby (soft play) area is for the use of children under 18 months only.
- The village area and junior play frame are for the use of children under 5 only.
- The main frame should not be used by children under 5 unless accompanied by a responsible adult (aged 18 or over); you may be asked for ID.
